



## Executive Regulation

# For Controls and Procedures Pertaining to Financial Dues for Environmental Licenses, Permits, and Services

For the Environmental Law issued by the Royal Decree

No. (m/165), dated 19/11/1441 Hijri

**\*\*\* Note: In the event of any discrepancy between the Arabic original version of this Executive Regulation and its English translation, the Arabic version prevails \*\*\***





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## **Article (1) – Definitions**

The following terms and expressions - wherever they appear in this Executive Regulation – shall have the meanings set forth below, , except where it is therein expressly otherwise:

**Law:** Environmental Law.

**Executive Regulation:** Executive Regulation for Controls and Procedures Pertaining to Financial Dues for Environmental Licenses, Permits, and Services.

**Ministry:** Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture.

**Minister:** Minister of Environment, Water and Agriculture.

**Fund:** Environment Fund.

**Competent Center:** The National Center for Environmental Compliance, the National Center for Vegetation Cover and Combating Desertification, or the National Center for Wildlife Development.

**Founding Regulations:** Founding regulations of the competent center.

**Person:** Any public or private natural or legal person.

**Activity:** Any industrial, commercial, or service-related facility, project, business, or other activities that are expected to have an environmental impact.

**Permit:** A document issued by the competent center to a person before undertaking any activity.

**Environmental Permit for Operation:** A document issued by the National Center for Environmental Compliance to a person before operating or undertaking any new activity; or in order to resume or continue operating an existing activity.

**License:** A document issued by the competent center authorizing a person to undertake an environmental activity.

**Environmental Services:** Services provided by the competent center to persons, such as reviewing studies submitted to the Center and others.

**Financial Dues:** An amount of money collected by the competent center from a person for the purpose of issuing or renewing licenses or permits or for providing environmental services.

**Environmental Impact Coefficient:** Coefficient set by the National Center for Environmental Compliance based on the environmental impact of types of activities, such as mining, energy, industry, and other activities. This coefficient is utilized to compute the financial dues for the environmental permit for operation in accordance with the provisions of this Executive Regulation.

**Activity's Environmental Compliance Coefficient:** Coefficient set by the National Center for Environmental Compliance for each activity based on the level of its environmental compliance. This coefficient is utilized to compute the financial dues for the environmental permit for operation operate in accordance with the provisions of this Executive Regulation, and is aimed at promoting environment-friendly practices.

**Financial Dues Charter:** Document issued by the competent center that shows the financial dues' computation mechanism for each category of activities, the amounts thereof, the collection mechanism, and any related requirements, in accordance with the provisions of this Executive Regulation.





## **Article (2) – The Competent Center’s Scope of Work Regarding Financial Dues**

Each competent center shall undertake, within its jurisdiction, the following tasks related to dues:

- (1) Setting the environmental impact coefficient for all the categories or types of activities.
- (2) Defining the financial dues’ collection mechanism.
- (3) Issuing the financial dues charter for environmental permits, licenses, and services in accordance with the provisions of this Executive Regulation.
- (4) Collecting the financial dues and depositing the amounts in the fund.
- (5) Implementing the provisions of the Executive Regulation.

## **Article (3) – Financial Dues for Environmental Permits, Licenses, and Services**

- (1) The Competent center shall, pursuant to provisions of its founding regulations, the financial dues needed for the issuance of environmental permits, licenses, and services, to be set forth in the financial dues charter, provided that such dues do not exceed the ceilings set forth in Appendix (1) of these Executive Regulations.
- (2) The Deputy Ministry for Environment shall draft updates to the ceilings’ table in Appendix (1) of these Executive Regulations and append new activities thereto, every three (3) years or whenever the need arises, for the Minister’s approval.

## **Article (4) – Financial Dues for Environmental Permit for operation**

- (1) The payment of financial dues for issuing the environmental permit for operation aims at ensuring that the pertinent activities contribute to limiting cumulative costs of environmental impact resulting from their operation. This financial due is computed based on several factors, including:
  - a. Activity size; and the National Center for Environmental Compliance may adopt appropriate indicators for the size of each activity to be set forth in the environmental dues charter, such as the annual production of the activity, its production capacity, or other relevant indicators.
  - b. Environmental impact of the type of activity.
  - c. Level of environmental compliance of the activity.
- (2) The Deputy Ministry for Environment shall draft, for the Minister’s approval, a table setting the ceilings for the environmental impact coefficient by type of activity. The table shall be updated every three (3) years or whenever the need arises, taking into consideration that the financial dues for the environmental permit for operation shall have a minimal impact on the overall costs of producer and end-consumer.





- (3) The National Center for Environmental Compliance shall, in accordance with provisions of its founding regulations, stipulate in the financial dues charter the environmental impact coefficient for all types of activities, with the following being adhered to:
- Not to exceed the ceilings for environmental impact coefficient as set by the Ministry pursuant to clause (2) of this article.
  - To cover all segments across the chain of production, and avoid any duplication in calculating the amount of such financial dues.
  - In cases where the coefficients in the table issued by the Ministry, pursuant to clause (2) of this article, cover more than one segment of the chain of production, the National Center for Environmental Compliance shall set the coefficient for each segment, provided that the cumulative coefficient amount for the chain of production does not exceed the ceiling set by the Ministry for the whole chain.
- (4) The National Center for Environmental Compliance shall identify and set the activity's environmental compliance coefficient, which ranges between (0.8) for activities demonstrating a high environmental compliance and (1.2) for activities with low environmental compliance.
- (5) The National Center for Environmental Compliance shall annually compute the number of financial dues for the environmental permit for operation that is due from each person using the following equation:

$$\text{Annual Financial Dues for the Environmental Permit for Operation} = \text{Environmental Impact Coefficient of the Activity Type} \times \text{Activity Size} \times \text{Activity's Environmental Compliance Coefficient}$$

- (6) The National Center for Environmental Compliance shall collect the annual financial dues for the environmental permit for operation in the first quarter of each calendar year, or in parts of the year, including environmental permits for operation whose validity period varies between (3) and (6) years.
- (7) The environmental permits for operation must not be renewed before the person fully settles the financial dues amount.
- (8) The Ministry and the National Center for Environmental Compliance may exempt any activity from paying financial dues for environmental permit for operation, partially or completely, upon Minister's approval.
